

Spring cleaning 101: don't forget these 7 tasks

- 1. **Garbage cans**. Even if you empty them regularly, garbage cans can quickly accumulate bacteria and unpleasant odours. Be sure to wash them out with vinegar and hot water.

How to wash windows without leaving streaks

Make a homemade cleaning liquid by mixing a three-to-one solution of water and white vinegar in a spray bottle. Generously spray this solution onto the glass. Use a cloth or squeegee to wipe it clean. Then, remove any liquid residue with a dry cloth. If you still notice streaks, dampen a piece of crumpled

newspaper and rub it on the glass to achieve a streak-free finish.
